

## Findings and Decisions following Fitness to Practise Committee Inquiries (Nurses Act, 1985)

## Name: Rezel M. Deang Mara, P.I.N. 93254 Finding of the Fitness to Practise Committee: Professional Misconduct

## Allegations proven:

That Ms. Mara, being a registered nurse, while employed as a Clinical Nurse Manager at X Nursing Home, on or around 16 and/or 17 November 2010:

- On one or more occasions, failed to monitor and/or supervise, adequately or at all, the nursing staff and/or care staff for whom she was responsible;
- On one or more occasions, failed to ensure that one or more of the staff members referred to above were discharging their duties adequately or at all;
- In respect of Ms X, a resident in Ms. Mara's care:
  - Failed to ensure that her monitoring checks were carried out in a timely manner and/or at all;
  - Failed to ensure that the recording(s) of her monitoring checks were completed in an appropriate manner and/or in a timely manner and/or were not completed in advance;
- Failed to conduct any or any adequate ward round(s)
- Placed the health and/or safety of the residents under Ms. Mara's care at risk.

**Sanction**: Pursuant to Section 41 (1) of the Nurses Act, 1985, Ms. Mara was **censured** in relation to her professional conduct.
