

Findings and Decisions following Fitness to Practise Committee Inquiries (Nurses Act, 1985)

Name: Ms. Ann Patricia McNulty, P.I.N. 40003

Finding of the Fitness to Practise Committee: Professional Misconduct and unfitness to engage in the practice of nursing by reason of a physical or mental disability

Allegations proven:

- You have failed to comply with one or more of Conditions 3, 4 and 5 attached to the retention of your name in the Register of Nurses.
 - o That you are obliged to provide random supervised urinalysis on a monthly basis to your G.P. or to Occupational Health for a period of two years.
 - o That you attend after-care at X for a period of at least 24 months and thereafter as advised by X and that X provides An Bord Altranais with monthly reports.
 - o That you are obliged to provide evidence to An Bord Altranais of compliance with the conditions attached to your registration in writing every three months.
- You are or have been suffering from a physical or mental disability rendering you unfit to engage in the practice of nursing.

Sanction: Pursuant to Section 39 (1) of the Nurses Act, 1985, Ms. McNulty's name was **erased** from the Register of Nurses and Midwives. The decision to erase Ms. McNulty's name from the Register of Nurses and Midwives was confirmed by the High Court on 11th November, 2013.
