

Findings and Decisions following Fitness to Practise Committee Inquiries

(Nurses Act, 1985)

Name: Ms. Kathleen Philomena O'Carroll, P.I.N. 26784 Finding of the Fitness to Practise Committee: Professional Misconduct

Allegations proven against Ms. O'Carroll:

That you, being a registered nurse, while employed at X Hospital, while on night duty on or around $24^{\text{th}}/25^{\text{th}}$ June 2008 and in respect of the treatment afforded by you to Mr. X:

- Failed to provide any or any adequate care to Mr. X and
- Failed to conduct any or any adequate ward rounds and
- Failed to act in the best interest of Mr. X.

Sanction: Pursuant to Section 41 (1) of the Nurses Act, 1985, Ms. O'Carroll was **advised** in relation to her professional conduct and pursuant to Section 40 (1) of the Act, a **condition** was attached to the retention of her name in the Register. The decision to attach a condition to the retention of Ms. O' Carroll's name in the Register was confirmed by the High Court on 27^{th} June, 2011.
