Opportunities for further analysis and alignment of language

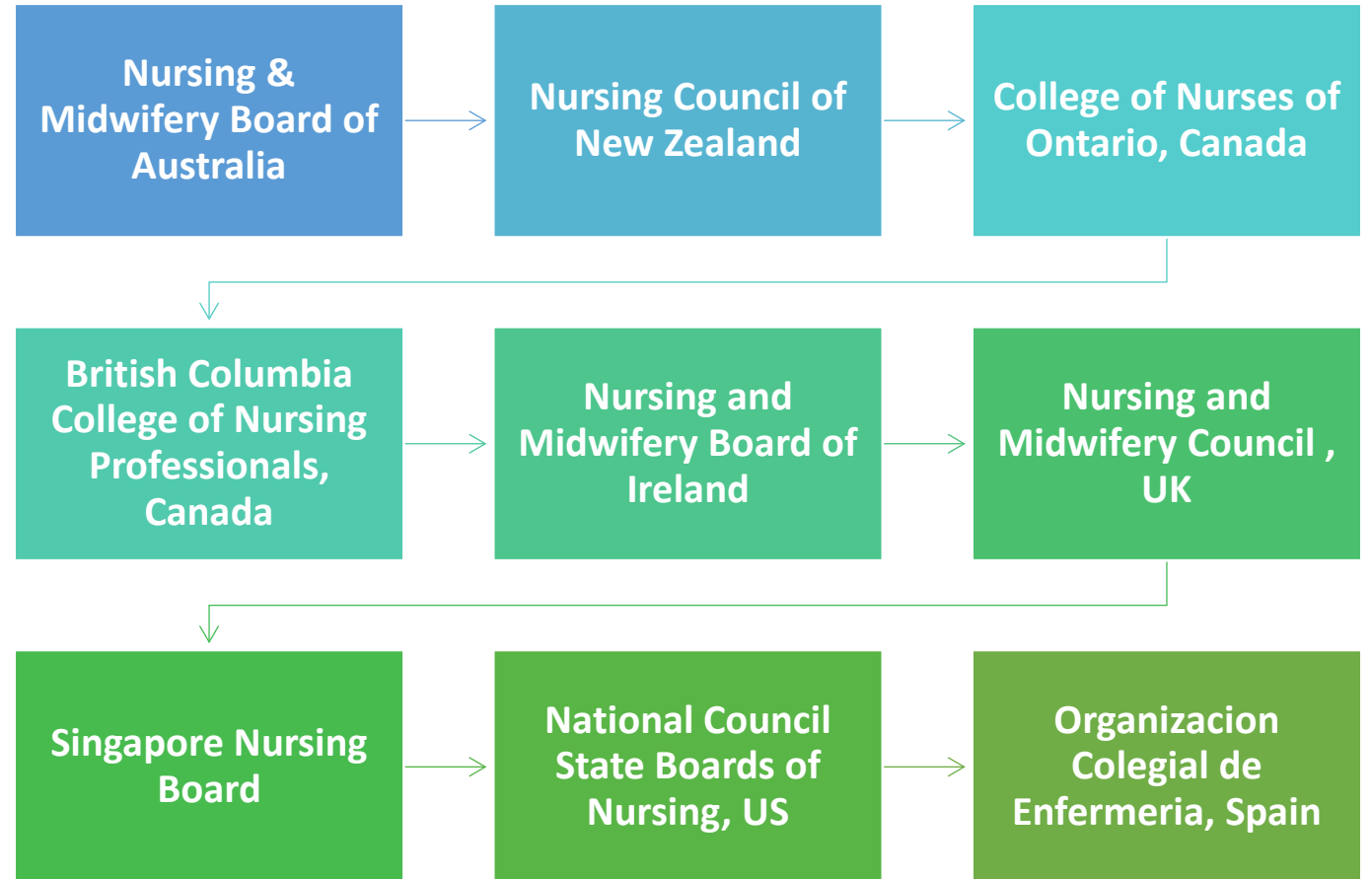
