## **Findings and Decisions following Fitness to Practise Committee Inquiries**

(Nurses Act, 1985)

**Name: Ms. Celia Tyrrell, P.I.N. 55266**

**Finding of the Fitness to Practise Committee: Professional Misconduct**

### **Allegations proven against Ms. Tyrrell:**

That you, while employed as a staff nurse by X Nursing Home between on or around 23<sup>rd</sup> October 2003 and on or around 10<sup>th</sup> August 2009:

- On one or more occasions, took without any or any adequate authority, one or more blank prescriptions from X Nursing Home
- On one or more occasions, completed one or more of the prescriptions referred to above in your own favour
- On one or more occasions, forged the signature of one or more medical practitioners, to include Dr .X, on one or more of the prescriptions referred to above

**Sanction:** Pursuant to Section 41 (1) of the Nurses Act, 1985, Ms. Tyrrell was **censured** in relation to her professional conduct and pursuant to Section 40 (1) of the Act, **conditions** were attached to the retention of her name in the Register of Nurses and Midwives. The decision to attach conditions to the retention of Ms. Tyrrell's name in the Register of Nurses and Midwives was confirmed by the High Court on 5<sup>th</sup> November, 2012.
